FORMATION UPDATES

Formation Year 2024-2025 - Began with our annual retreat August 10th-11th, 2024. Deacon Arturo and Esperanza Monterrubio from Maryknoll Missions will be leading these couples. We currently have nine men and wives in their second year of Candidacy, and 13 men and wives in second year of Aspirancy. Please also keep in prayer our 16 couples who will enter into their Formal Discernment year.

Continuing Formation for Newly Ordained - We are excited to announce per the requirements in the revised National Directory, we will be piloting the first year of a 5-year continuing formation cycle for the newly ordained. The 18 men just ordained a part of Cohort 2024 will be the pilot group. The first year will consist of five Saturday workshops spread throughout their first year of ministry, where they will process their ministerial experiences through the lens of their prior formation. The workshops will be in diverse locations throughout the diocese so they become more familiar with parishes in different deaneries. We hope that future years will include workshops that may be accessed equally between the newly ordained and those of us more experienced in ministry. We are very thankful to Deacon German Romero and his team who laid the foundation for this first year.



CONTINUING FORMATION

Upcoming Opportunities with University of Dayton Virtual Learning Community - We are working with the University of Dayton to create online courses that could directly benefit our deacons.





We have also been working on additional courses to address existing ministerial challenges. One course would help non-Hispanic deacons increase their understanding of various Hispanic cultures as well as liturgical and pastoral Spanish.

We are excited to share they have announced a new course, "Curricula del Idioma Español para el Ministerio Liturgico." The course objective is through cultural, grammar, and pastoral aspects modules the participants will enhance their intercultural competence, master grammar fundamentals, and integrate pastoral practices essential for effective ministry in diverse contexts. Deacon Dave plans to give this online course a test run in the fall and hopefully be able to broadly recommend it soon thereafter.
