ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF FORMATION

We are expanding the staff in the Office of Permanent Deacons due to the workload that has dramatically increased over the past six years. With approximately 275 deacons in the Diocese of Orlando, and a robust formation program, there is the need to have a new full-time Associate Director. We plan to have this position filled by the beginning of the new fiscal year. The ideal candidate will have a background in curriculum design and delivery as well as skills necessary to coordinate all aspects of a complex formation program. CONTINUING FORMATION FORM


After a year of review, proposed modifications and more review; and partnering with the deacon dean leads and the formation team, we will be using an updated Continuing Formation form as part of next year's Annual Forms.

The biggest change is that the Continuing Formation Form will appropriately narrow its focus to Formation Activities. Previously, we could count performing some of our ministerial duties as "continuing formation." However, simply presiding at Eucharistic Exposition or funeral services, or delivering homilies, while good and necessary things, are not representative of Continuing Formation.

Continuing Formation is properly defined as activities that help us acquire knowledge or develop new skills to become better deacons. This includes reading books on spiritual or theological topics, participating in relevant courses either in person or online, attending retreats, pilgrimages or days of reflection, and similar activities. Another question that often arises is how to count the "Continuing Units." Per the recommendation of one of our deaneries we will have an "application chart" where you will look up an activity and find out how many units apply.


